To our students:

Continuation of the management policy of Graduate School of Health Sciences and Faculty of Health Sciences regarding emergency declaration from the Japanese government.

Based on "Kobe University's response to the new coronavirus infectious disease (8th report)" announced by the President of Kobe University on April 28, and "Kobe University's activity restrictions guidelines for preventing the spread of new coronavirus infection", Graduate School of Health Sciences and Faculty of Health Sciences, School of Medicine has decided to continue the following management policy announced on April 8, "Management policy of Graduate School of Health Sciences and Faculty of Health Sciences regarding emergency declaration from the Japanese government."

Future policy revisions will be judged according to the activity restriction level set by the University. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Notes:

1. Students of the Faculty of Health Sciences and the Graduate School of Health Sciences are prohibited from going to the campus and must stay at home.
2. Remote lectures will continue for the students of the Faculty of Health Sciences and the Graduate School of Health Sciences.
3. For students who do not have a sufficient Web access, we will provide them

with a lesson based on the lecture materials so that inequality does not occur in learning opportunities.

4. Research activities of doctoral students of graduate schools and 4th graders of the Faculty of Health Sciences are also prohibited. However, indispensable tasks such as laboratory animal breeding are permitted to be conducted upon entering the school building on the premise of a small number of people and short working hours, with the permission of the supervisor.

5. Entrance is limited to the front entrance of Building B only. If you enter the building, write your name, entry time, body temperature, exit time, reason for entry, etc. on the visitors log book.
